Some information for the **2024-25 – U16 Rep Colts** season plan...

Tournaments – the team will be participating in 3 or 4 tournaments

Player Selection – Tryout information will be communicated via the CMHA website and CMHA's Facebook page – with information provided when available. Tryouts will include skills sessions, intra squad games, and possibly exhibition games. Independent evaluators will be used to support the evaluation process of goalies, and players will be assessed on individual skills (e.g. skating, passing, shooting) and game skills (e.g. engaging in the play, team play). Players will be evaluated both ON-ICE and OFF-ICE – from the time they arrive at the rink.
